5. Passports & Microchips should be read by a veterinary surgeon at the final.
6. Foals qualified for final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show where the final is held.
7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.

*Description:* Open to Thoroughbred horses that have either been officially named or unnamed. Passport (Weatherbys if IRE or GB, or other racing relevant authority if from any other country) to be available for inspection on the day of the show. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday. Riders should prepare an individual show. This is a hunter style class to display walk, trot, canter, gallop and halt. There will be a ride judge for this class. Conformation will not be considered.

In all classes ponies and riders should be neatly turned out. All Riders must wear helmets which comply with up to date safety standards. The following classes are Equitation classes which are judged on the riders ability only.

## RULES & CONDITIONS:

1. Riders may compete in one equitation class only.
2. Ponies may enter multiple classes with different riders. This is to accomodate families with one pony and multiple riders.
3. Ponies must be 4 years old or over.
4. Snaffle bridles only.
5. Riders will be judged in two phases: riding collectively (with all competitors in the class following the instructions of the steward to walk, trot, change direction, canter (depending on the class) and halt and salute) and riding individually (each rider puts on a small show for the judge while the others stand in line.
6. Riders will be judged on the following; (i) Performance as above (ii) Position and seat of the rider (iii) Correct use and effectiveness of the aids
