The committee of Tullow Agricultural Show reserve the right to replace prize money with vouchers/product to the equivalent value. Prizes may be forfeited if winning exhibits are removed before 3pm. See Rule 9. Where there are insufficient entries the committee have the right to amalgamate or cancel the class and refund the entry fee.

Exhibitors of Horses, Sheep, Cattle are permitted ONE handler per vehicle free. All other passengers must pay.

Intending exhibitors are advised to ensure that their Public Liability Policy covers the exhibition of livestock at Public Shows. See Rule 37.

Note for information regarding Movement of Bovine to Shows

The Department of Agriculture implemented a number of changes on the 4th February 2019 which changed the procedures and criteria applicable when applying for a Certificate of Compliance for the movement of cattle. These also impact on the certificate which is required when moving bovine to a show.

The following sets out the criteria applicable:

- The movment of cattle to and from an Agricultural Show within the state must be recorded on the Animal Identification and Movement System (AIM).
- In line with these changes, a specific certificate of compliance for the "Movement of Bovine from a Single Holding to a Show" must now be requested prior to the movement of animals concerned.
- These certificates can be created by (i) applying online using their ag-food account or (ii) where the keeper is not online, the certificate can be generated by the local Regional Veterinary Office following receipt of a NBAS31K with issue of the certificate being subject to normal criteria applicable. This form will be available on the Department's Website and will also be included with the show circular when issued.
- When applying for this certificate the destination herd/ or Show number is not required. The certificate generated will include a "S" symbol.
- The certificate of Compliance for a Show will continue to be valid for a period of up to 30 days. As is currently the case these can be used for the movement of animals to a number of shows during the validity period of the certificate.
- Please also note, calves which are less than 10 days cannot be moved to a Show.

As is currently the case the Movement Notification Section of the Certificate should be completed by the keeper and the Show Secretrary who must clearly indicate the Show Number. The Show movement should be recorded on the passport. Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling these requirements lies with the Show Secretary. If the animals move to a herd other than the source herd, the new destination herd must complete and sign the certificate also. Completed forms should be sent by the Show Secretary to the local RVO within 7 days of the show.
